

Cornerstone is an arts centre.

You can come here to see shows, take part in a workshop, see art in our gallery or visit our café bar.

Front doors

When you arrive at Cornerstone you can come through our main automatic glass doors.



You can also enter through another set of automatic glass doors which lead into our café called Nourish.

It doesn't matter which way you come in.

When you walk in you will see our box office, the café and the gallery.





Box office

If you are visiting Cornerstone to see a performance you will need a ticket.

You can buy the ticket in advance or buy it on the day from our box office.

The box office desk is circular in shape.







Nourish

The café is called Nourish and is where you can buy drinks and food.

There are comfortable chairs to sit on and music playing.

It can be very busy in the cafe.



Gallery

There may be paintings, drawings or photographs or other things that you can look at in our gallery.

Sometimes it is a nice, quiet place to sit.

Sometimes you can hear music or people talking in the café.

Cloakroom

There is a cloakroom where you can leave your coat if you don't want to take it into a performance.



Toilets

There are toilets next to the cloakroom and box office. There is a disabled toilet downstairs as well. There is a changing places toilet upstairs near the auditorium.



Lift

There is a lift which can take you up to the auditorium.

Stairs

Or you might choose to use the stairs. It is up to you.



THE AUDITORIUM

The stage may look big with black curtains on either side.

It may have people on it or furniture, or instruments or a big screen. You might see something that makes you feel sad or upset.

At the end of the show, everyone will clap their hands because they enjoyed the show.

At the end of the show you leave the auditorium.

You can stay in the café or the gallery for a while if you want or you can go straight home.
